Baltimore ranks No. 3 in best places to find a job

Baltimoreans have it relatively easy when job searching, according to one jobs posting search engine.

Charm City ranks the third-least difficult to find a job, trailing Washington, D.C., and San Jose, Calif., according to Juju.com. Boston and New York rounded out the top five.

The list ranks cities according to the number of unemployed individuals, as reported by the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics, per advertised job listing.

Baltimore has 2.91 people looking for work for each advertised job, according to Juju. San Jose has 2.68 unemployed people per job, while Washington has 1.87.

As a state, Maryland ranked fifth, with 3.86 unemployed people per job listing. The District of Columbia, Virginia, North Dakota and Massachusetts ranked ahead of Maryland.

Detroit and Michigan ranked the worst among cities and states, with 20.76 unemployed people per job listing in the city and 18.97 job seekers per listing statewide.
